Holy Family School and Preschool is the largest single ministry and outreach of *Holy Family* Catholic Parish. While it is not the sole ministry of the parish, it is a vital one in helping the youth of our community to know, love, and serve Christ in the Church.


This past summer, a significant upgrade to the 1961 wing of our school building was undertaken. If you have had the opportunity to see it, you will agree it has been a huge and much needed improvement. During last year's request, parish and school leadership shared the intent to renovate the 2nd floor of the 1964 school building in the summer of 2019. In addition to the surface finishes, lights, and upgraded heating and air, the plan for this renovation includes both the upper and lower bathrooms in this wing. Plumbing upgrades add significantly to the cost, but are much needed.

The construction estimate for this next phase of work is \$365,000. Due to tremendous support of the parish and school families last year and advance donations this year, we already have \$217,000 on-hand or pledged for the next phase of the renovations. This leaves us only \$148,000 remaining. We are well on our way. All monies raised here, stay here, and will be applied directly to the 1964 Renovation project.

As primary beneficiaries of the renovation, we are asking each and every school family to make a contribution by completing the enclosed pledge card and returning it in the provided envelope. Every contribution is valued and moves us closer to our shared goal of a quality education environment for our children. You may participate with a one-time pledge by sending your full donation now, or you may choose to make 12 payments in 2019 through one of the options listed. If you are unable to participate monetarily, we ask you to please support the drive with your prayers.
